Expressive Arts ECA Provision 24/25

Mondays:

KJS Singers: Sing, chant, dance, and play in a beginning choir for young voices. This ECA is designed for students in Y1-3 to explore their voices through a variety of songs, singing games and exercises. Students who excel may be recommended for KJS Choir
